Abundant fresh, red fruit aromas of ripe Bing cherry, strawberry and pomegranate are accented by floral hibiscus and brambly, herbal undertones. Bright red fruit aromas carry onto the palate where a smooth mouthfeel supports full body, pleasant tannins and juicy acidity. Aged in neutral oak, this Pinot Noir highlights the fruit forward nature from ideal growing conditions of the 2014 vintage.

Our 2014 vintage in Oregon may be remembered as the vintage of a lifetime. It was a really warm year with an ideal, long growing season, one of the largest yield we have seen at WBJ. In fact, 2014 not only showed great quantity, but yields were also high, and showing great quality. The fruit was lush and showed tremendous flavor, depth, balance and complexity. This is a vintage to look forward to through 2020.
