Vibrant aroma with a baseline of floral rhubarb and hibiscus that allow highlights of bright raspberry and stone fruit. A light juicy entry transitions to a medium weight body with flavors mirroring the aroma along with ripe strawberry and pomegranate. An assertive style of dry rose with body to support refreshing acid that carries into a medium-long finish. Perfect for your backyard BBQ's, picnics and even your Thanksgiving roasted turkey.

The 2016 growing season continued to push the envelope for defining the new normal in Oregon as one of the earliest on record. An unusually warm spring gave way to moderate summer conditions, which provided even growing conditions through véraison. Though it was an intense growing season due to the early start, the fruit produced throughout the state resulted in wonderful concentration and complexity with characteristic natural acidity.
