



REALLY GOOD WINE MADE IN OREGON

Bright citrus fruit aromas of fresh pineapple and lemon/grapefruit zest blend with floral hints of melon and honey. The palate opens with crisp acidity followed by smooth, medium body with flavors that mirror the aroma. A long finish is carried by the luscious body and juicy acid. Sourced from our estate, Sea Breeze Vineyard in the Van Duzer corridor, this is a rare Pinot Blanc in production size with incredible value, emblematic of the region and unique to the vineyard site.

The 2016 growing season continued to push the envelope for defining the new normal in Oregon as one of the earliest on record. An unusually warm spring gave way to moderate summer conditions, which provided even growing conditions through véraison. Though it was an intense growing season due to the early start, the fruit produced throughout the state resulted in wonderful concentration and complexity with characteristic natural acidity.
