



REALLY GOOD WINE MADE IN OREGON

An explosion of fruit, floral, and spice aromas found in strawberry, peach, pomegranate, rose, jasmine, bubblegum, and white pepper entices the senses from the first swirl. Juicy acid countered with medium body supports a crisp, fresh flavor profile redolent with notes of grapefruit, banana, watermelon, orange marmalade, and cherry Lifesaver. A clean, bright finish with lingering acidity makes this rosé the perfect partner for year-round enjoyment.

The 2017 Willamette Valley growing season began with a more typical bud break in mid-April, compared to an earlier start in 2016. Excellent conditions at bloom resulted in a heavy fruit set that, even with thinning, yielded 10-15% more fruit than average at harvest. A warm, dry summer followed by late September rains and early fall cool temperatures slowed ripening and ensured high quality fruit that was mature yet not overripe.
