CANS + WINE:

The cans do not affect the quality of the wine - AT ALL. As long as the wine that goes into the can is good, it will be preserved as such, and ours is great! If anything, the seal on cans is tighter than bottled wine, it helps keep out sun light, there is little chance of oxygen getting in and it stays fresh!

HOW LONG WILL THE WINE STAY FRESH?

3+ years. However, we'll go ahead and say, this isn't a wine bottle that you "lay down in the cellar" -- pop open the can and sip now!

WILL THERE BE A "TINNY" TASTE?

Does beer taste tinny in a can? Does Coca-Cola taste tinny in a can? There are many beverages we enjoy from cans, Joe To Go is no different, except that it's really good wine you can take anywhere!

LINED CANS:

Nearly all aluminum and steel beverage and food cans today are lined. These linings extend shelf life, protect the can's contents from the metal packaging and protect the packaging from the contents. We go the extra mile and submit our wines for corrosivity testing to make sure the cans are safe to use.
