



REALLY GOOD WINE MADE IN OREGON

Bright, juicy aromas of homemade berry pie play with spicy undertones of green cardamom and sage in this soft, approachable Pinot Noir. A mouthwatering acid entry gives way to youthful tannins on the mid palate, which carry through to the medium-long finish. Flavors of red plum, blackberry compote and - we swear! Haribo raspberry gummis counterpoint with black pepper and just a hint of maple syrup for an eminently quaffable Pinot that's prime time for Meatball Monday, Pizza night, or even Thanksgiving Thursday and all the feasts in between.

The 2016 growing season continued to push the envelope for defining the new normal in Oregon as one of the earliest on record. An unusually warm spring gave way to moderate summer conditions, which provided even growing conditions through véraison. Though it was an intense growing season due to the early start, the fruit produced throughout the state resulted in wonderful concentration and complexity with characteristic natural acidity.
